

Combine vs Stagger Renovation Planner

Lean toward combining when

1 Rooms adjoin or share plumbing

One crew opens the wall once, so the saving is largest.

2 The full budget is ready

You can fund both rooms now without straining cash flow.

3 You want one clean hit

Get the dust and noise over in a single concentrated stretch.

4 You want matching finishes

Design both rooms together for a consistent look.

Lean toward staggering when

1 Cash flow is tight

Two phases spread the spend across your budget cycle.

2 You cannot lose both rooms

Keep a working kitchen or bathroom at all times.

3 The rooms are far apart

Little shared-trade saving if plumbing runs are separate.

4 Only one room is urgent

Fix the pressing problem now, plan the other properly.
